

Reindeer hardly ever populate parks in Western Europe; they are still an exceptional feature. They need special housing and care, and above all, well thought-out feed.

Well-balanced feed is essential, especially for procreation. All in all: feed tailored to their requirements is an absolute must for reindeer.

When living in the wild, reindeer feast on lichens, herbage and twigs. Their basic feed is soft hay and straw when they are kept in parks. Based on long-time experience, Garvo composed the *Reindeer pellets* 8 mm pellet especially for reindeer. With this pellet, great attention is given to the large quantities of fat and vitamins. The pellet is a concentrate. Together with roughage, *reindeer pellets* comes close to the nutritional value of the reindeer's natural diet.

If you use the diet guidelines, the rations will provide the daily allowance, and contribute to:

- Dry-muscled animals (as 'wild' animals should be);
- Maximum resistance;
- Hard hooves;
- Perfect hormone level, giving a good fertility, uncomplicated gestation, easy birth and trouble-free suckling period.



Feeding advice: 0.5 - 0.7 kilos of *reindeer pellets* per 100 kilos of body weight in addition to unlimited quantities of straw (preferably rye or oat straw) and a limited quantity of soft hay.
