

Gum Arabic

For your Gumnivorous animals

Gum arabic, a natural gum also called gum acacia, is a substance that is taken from two sub-Saharan species of the acacia tree, *Acacia senegal* and *Acacia seyal*. Gum arabic is a complex mixture of saccharides and glycoproteins.



Gum arabic can be fed on a daily basis to marmosets, tamarins and other gumnivorous animals.

Analyses:

Protein:		max. 2.5%
Fat:	0%	
Moisture:		max. 10%
Carbohydrates:	min. 80%	max. 85%
Total ash:		max. 4%
Calcium:	min. 0.5%	max. 1%
Sodium:		max. 0.5%
Potassium:	min. 0.2%	max. 0.7%
Magnesium:	min. 0.1%	max. 0.3%

Mix with an appropriate amount of water and blend with a spoon.
