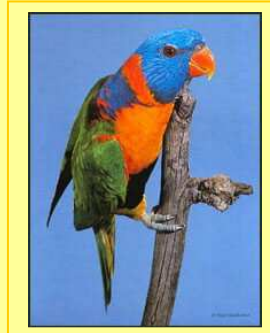


NECTAR~LORI



Product: Nectar~Lori

Description: Nectar ~ Lori is a complete and water-soluble diet for all lories and hanging parakeets. Avian Lori contains all necessary nutrients, carbohydrates, protein, fats, minerals, vitamins and amino acids required by your birds. Avian Lori contains 21 different essential and non-essential amino acids. The addition of 0.5% Spirulina prevents the food acidifying. You only should supply Avian Lori once a day. The durability is at least 24 hours. The phyto nutrients in the spirulina, has a very positive effect on the coloring of the feathers. It can be, scientifically, that the Lories need only nectar, but you must, because of variations, also feed a firm food as well, such as fruit, apple, pear, grapes, orange, pomegranate, papaya, guava, banana and cactus figs. Many Lories like to eat flowers, such as Fuchsia, Begonia, Wallflowers, Honeysuckle, Dandelion and other flowers to receive the nectar.

Contents: Avian Lori formulation contains: a mixture of glucose, fructose, sugar, soy-protein, amino acids, bee pollen, vitamins, minerals, trace elements, and 0.5% spirulina

Minerals: Potassium, calcium, magnesium, phosphorous.

Trace elements: copper, manganese, zinc, molybdenum, iodine, fluoride

Vitamins: A, D³, E, K¹, B¹, Nicotinamide, B⁶, Folic acid, Panthothenic acid, B¹², Biotin.

Amino-acids: L-Alanin, L-Arginin, L-Asparagin, L-Cystin, L-Glutamin, Glycin, L-Histidin, L-Isoleucin, L-Leucin, L-Methionin, L-Prolin, L-Phenylalanin, L-Serin, L-Threonin, L-Tryptophan, L-Tyrosin, L-Valin..

Packing: 1000 gramme, 5000 gramme and 10 kg.

Preparation: Mix 20 gramme (1 full measuring spoon) Avian Lori with 100 ml. of water. Stir thoroughly and put it aside for approx. 3 minutes. After that, stir the mix again and you will see, the contents will become jelly-like. This is to avoid ingredients to sink, whereby your birds have to drink the water first before they will get to the nutrients. Give each day fresh Avian Lori.
