

Frozen Willow


- High quality willow branches -

- Easy to thaw separately -

Roughage is a necessary source of long fibers for exotic herbivores. Because of the specialized digestive system of browsers, it is important to feed the right source of roughage: browse. Willow is a very suitable browse species to feed to all kind of browsers with a high acceptance.

Analyses

- * High fiber content: 32 g/100 g DS
- * Low iron content: 122 mg/kg DS
- * Ideal fiber fractions for browsing species, with a high ADL content:



Process

1. The willow branches are harvested, only the thin twigs with leaves are used



2. The branches are cut into smaller pieces and packed in containers.



3. The bundels are frozen in containers of around 300 kg. These are sealed to prevent dehydration of the willow.
